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PROFILE

Anna Depalmas is Full Professor of Prehistory and Protohistory in the University of Sassari.

She is specialized in archaeology and a PhD in prehistoric archaeology.

Her researches are mainly focused on the Nuragic period, spatial distribution, settlement development and social organization of protohistoric communities, navigation and transmarine traffic in the Mediterranean during the Bronze and Iron Ages, protohistoric pottery manufacturing and metallurgical technologies through instrumental and diagnostic analyses. She deals with museology and the valorization of archaeological heritage.

She has carried out several research and excavation surveys in Sardinia (Iloi-Sedilo, Abini-Teti, Santa Cristina-Paulilatino, etc.) and abroad, particularly in Tunisia and Menorca in the framework of archaeological and ethno-archaeological projects.

She has participated as speaker in more than 180 scientific conferences in Italy and abroad and has conducted more than 90 conferences at different Italian institutions.

She has published about 250 scientific articles and 4 monographic books.
